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This is LAAX

LAAX is located at 1,100 m above sea level in the Canton of Graubünden in Switzerland and is one of the most modern year-round destinations in the Alps. The region is a popular destination for outdoor fans, active families and freestylers in both winter and summer. 224 kilometers of slopes, 29 lifts and 5 snow parks with the largest halfpipe in the world ensure plenty of fun and action in the snow. What is a freestyle paradise in winter transformes into an adventure playground for young and old in summer – surrounded by the most impressive natural Alpine landscape. One of the most spectacular highlights is the Rhine Gorge, often referred to as the "Swiss Grand Canyon", with its dramatic rock formations and the Rhine river meandering through the middle of it. Also unique: the UNESCO World Heritage Site Tectonic Arena Sardona, where you can marvel at how the Alps were formed – a fascinating geological journey through time. Anyone longing to cool off on hot summer days cannot miss the famous Lake Cauma with its turquoise-blue, crystal-clear water. Amidst all this natural beauty, there are 330 km of bike trails and 250 km of hiking trails that invite guests to explore the most beautiful corners of the region.





Getting there

By plane

LAAX can be reached from Zurich International Airport in under two hours. LAAX can also be reached quickly from Basel and Friedrichshafen airports.

By car

From Zurich or Basel, follow the A13 highway in the direction of Chur and then take exit no. 18 in Reichenau. Then follow route no. 19 and you will be in LAAX within 20 minutes.

By public transport

Switzerland is known for its reliable, extensive public transport network. Thanks to this, getting to LAAX is very straightforward. First take the train to Chur, the capital of the Canton of Graubünden, and from there take the PostAuto bus directly to LAAX (stop "Laax GR, Bergbahnen") – the journey only takes 30 minutes. Alternatively, you can take the Rhaetian Railway (RhB) through the impressive Rhine Gorge to Ilanz. There is also a direct PostAuto bus connection from there to LAAX. All connections can be found on the SBB website or in the app.





Segnes & Runca Trail: fun & flow —


The Segnes Trail is a varied enduro trail for advanced bikers. At 3.7 km and over 310 meters in altitude, it leads from the Segnes Hut directly to the start of the Runca Trail. At 7.6 km, this is one of the longest flow trails in Europe and is characterized in particular by its versatility: Rookies roll over easy waves, pros jump over doubles, tables and waves.

Vorab Trail: from the glacier to the lake —

This trail is a must for enduring, experienced bikers who appreciate variety. The route starts in an alpine rocky landscape at the Vorab Glacier and leads downhill across lush alpine meadows and rooty passages. At times it leads into the Nagens Trail and can be extended from Flims into the depths of the Rhine Gorge, so that bikers end up covering 22 km and over 2,000 meters in altitude.

Never End Trail: downhill action —

The legendary Never End Trail is not for the fainthearted: on the 7 km long freeride route from Crap Sogn Gion to Laax, bikers descent over 1,100 meters in altitude. Initially rocky and alpine, the trail gradually winds its way through rooty passages down into the valley. Northshore elements are combined with wild nature and jumps with flowing sections – pure action and variety.



Action on the rocks Park Tower —

The rocks Park Tower provides the ultimate adrenaline rush in summer with three different activities: daredevils can plummet from a height of 30 meters at a controlled speed on the vertical drop. On the zipline, they fly across the rocksresort and those who like speed take the 73-metre-long slide to the base of the tower. Thrills are guaranteed!

Surf feeling at rocksresort Park —

Those who like to spend their vacation in the Swiss Alps instead of by the sea, can still experience that surfing feeling here. The rocksresort park is home to the urban surf wave and the Snakerun, where they can surf over asphalt waves on skateboards, scooters or BMX bikes. There is also a playground, a ninja park, trampolines and a multicourt for basketball and football.

Catching air at the Freestyle Academy —

Since 2010, the legendary LAAX Freestyle Academy has been offering a top-class playground to learn tricks, improve skills or simply have fun on 2,000 m². No matter what level or age – everyone is welcome. The hall was completely rebuilt and reopened in 2024. It houses various areas for skateboarding, trampolining and parkour.



UNESCO Heritage Sardona —

The collision of the two continents of Africa and Europe formed the Alps. In the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Sardona, this history of formation is more monumental than anywhere else. Due to its geological significance, the area of around 32,800 hectares has been designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The rugged Tschingel peaks, the Martinsloch and the lower and upper Segnesboden characterize this spectacular landscape.

Hiking by the water: 'Trutg dil Flem' —

The award-winning Flims Water Trail leads on 13 km from the lower Segnesboden past unique gorge landscapes to the village center of Flims, always along the 'Flem' river. Seven individually designed bridges by the famous Graubünden bridge builder Jürg Conzett are crossed along the way. Passages in the forest and occasional splashes of water provide refreshment on hot summer days.

Treetop walk 'Senda dil Dragun' —

With a length of 1.56 kilometers, the "Senda dil Dragun" (the path of the dragon) is the longest treetop walk in the world. On five platforms, it offers interesting facts about nature in the region and serves as an educational trail to raise awareness of the local flora and fauna. Kids can experience the trail in a playful way: There are five adventurous marble runs combined with exciting audio stories from the world of Ami Sabi the wizard.



Ami Sabi Summer Wonderland —

Only in LAAX: in the Ami Sabi Summer Wonderland and in the Ami Sabi Workshop, children aged between 4 and 12 learn about the local flora and fauna in a playful way. The wizard Ami Sabi conveys the content with creative songs and stories, which were written especially for this program by the well-known Graubünden artist Linard Bardill.

A day at picturesque mountain lakes—

Lake Cauma is considered the pearl of Flims. The turquoise-blue, crystal-clear water invites visitors to cool off on hot summer days. A large playground, paddleboards, pedal boats and much more guarantee an eventful day for the whole family. Hidden deeper in the Flims forest is Lake Cresta. It may be a little less well-known, but it is at least as beautiful.

Biking for kids: learn through play —

Under professional guidance, even the youngest guests in LAAX learn everything they need for mountain biking, from the basics to riding on the trails. The lessons are designed differently depending on the level and the course content is taught in an imaginative and age-appropriate way. LAAX School courses are available for children from the age of 4.




From exquisite to cozy and simple —
